Ephesus is among the most famous cities of the ancient period. Especially when it comes to the Roman Empire, Ephesus, the central city of the Province of Asia; It was impressive with its magnificent architectural structures and the plastic works attached to these structures. Undoubtedly, the most important source of this richness of the city is its hinterland surrounded by fertile lands opening into Anatolia and its extraordinarily useful port facing the capital Rome. Bülbül Mountain, which surrounds the area where the Ephesus Ancient City is located, is a sacred place especially for the Christian world.

Bülbül Mountain is very important for Christians as it houses the House of the Virgin Mary, with the big ceremony held on August 15 every year.

It is believed that the Virgin Mary spent her last days in this house.

Legend of the Seven Sleepers; It is based on the legend of six pious youths and their dogs, who escaped the compulsions of paganism and hid in a cave, where they awoke after 200 years of sleep of death.

This is the village that Greek writer Dido Sotiroyo mentioned in her work called "Say Hello from Me to Anatolia" and says "If there is such a thing as heaven on earth, our Kırkıca (Şirince) must be a part of that heaven"
